

JCDJFS School Clothing Voucher Program 2024

Applications must be complete, signed and dated to be valid.

Who qualifies?

- TANF eligible children ages 3 (as of 8/1/24) to age 18 (who have not yet graduated high school and are still enrolled).
- Income eligibility is at or below 200 % FPL.

How to apply?

- Applications are available online at www.jcdjfs.com, applications will be mailed upon request, or they can be picked up at the agency drop off box.
- Applications will be accepted **July 1st, 2024, through July 12th, 2024, by 4 PM** at the JCDJFS drop box, US mail (JCDJFS 125 S. 5th St. Steubenville OH 43952), email at Jeffersondocs@jfs.ohio.gov, or fax 740-282-5765.
- Only 1 voucher (\$200.00 value) per eligible child.

Who is NOT eligible?

- Those who are currently serving a sanction are not eligible.
- Those who have an outstanding overpayment who have not entered into a re-payment agreement with JCDJFS and are in current payment status (payment within the past 90 days) are not eligible.

What verifications are required?

- If you are applying for children that are **not** in receipt of SNAP, you must provide birth certificates or all minor children requesting a voucher and the past 30 days of all income received in the household.

How are vouchers distributed?

- Vouchers will be mailed to those who are eligible in the first week of August 2024.
- Those who are not eligible will receive a denial notice.

How can vouchers be used?

- Vouchers can be spent 8/1/2024 through 9/30/2024.
- Vouchers are valid at any clothing retailer willing to cooperate with JCDJFS.
- Each voucher must be **used in full at the same store**, any remaining voucher amount not spent at time of initial purchase is forfeited.
- There are no monetary refunds allowed, the only allowable exchange of goods is for the correct size for the child listed on the voucher, no other exchanges are acceptable.
- Lost or stolen vouchers will not be replaced.

All payments are contingent upon available funding.
